## Enrolment Process - Year 7, 2010

*The College does not conduct an entrance exam and accepts applications from boys of all ability levels. The College operates the model of integration of students with special needs into the general classroom programme.*

- Applications for enrolment must be returned to the College **no later than Thursday, 9 April.**
- All applicants, other than those with brothers currently attending the College, will be interviewed by appointment between 4 May and 5 June.
- You will be notified by mail at the beginning of May of the appointment time. The interview would normally be with the Headmaster or Deputy Headmaster of the College.
- If you have applied to more than one Catholic school, you will be asked at the interview to indicate your priority.
- Offers of enrolment will be posted Friday 26 June.
- Acceptances need to be received at the College no later than Friday, 10 July.
