



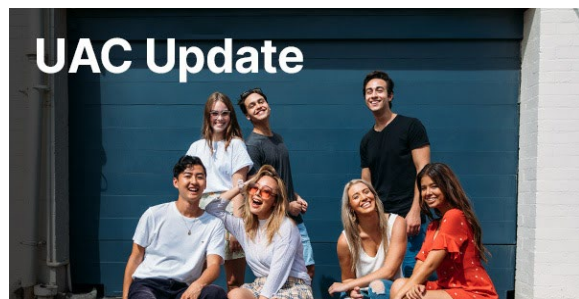

Do you need help financially? Have you done well academically? Maybe you are an elite athlete? Whatever your situation, a scholarship can help you succeed at university. Studying can be expensive. They have a wide range of scholarships available to you which can assist with living costs, text books or that can contribute towards your fees.



This year is certainly flying by. It's hard to believe we are only a few months away from HSC exams.

Undergraduate applications are streaming in steadily this year, with approximately 37,000 people having so far applied for university undergraduate study in 2023. As it is the beginning of August, I am happy to report that all Year 12 students across the country can now apply.

All undergraduate courses are now listed on the UAC website and available for students to preference in their application. If students can't find what they are looking for, please contact the Customer Service team for assistance. The UAC guide lists all phone numbers which allows you to call any UAC assistance team member.

Schools Recommendation Scheme

To date, UAC has received just over 11,000 SRS applications from across the country. This is one way students can receive an early offer based on Year 11 results and their school's recommendation.

Before students can apply for SRS they must submit their UAC application.

Three institutions have additional SRS criteria, and I would encourage students to check those details on the UAC website.

- Business Card. There are online options that allow you to construct a business card. A business card can be a great way of leaving your information with a prospective employer. They can keep it in their wallet and also give it to someone else if there are looking for an apprentice.
